Excited because we will have an opportunity to visit with many of our Seminole relatives, friends and visitors. This year we have an outstanding speaker – Denys Vasquez-Welch, a 4x-Granddaughter of Wannah, the sister of John Horse.

On August 15, 2024, we traveled to Oklahoma and were honored to have attended an event where the Oklahoma Department of Transportation erected a highway sign commemorating John Horse. The event was hosted by the Dosar Barkus Band of the Seminole Nation of Oklahoma. The 2 days of activities began on August 16 with a tour of the Oklahoma State Capitol. We then traveled to the Seminole Nation Museum at Wewoka, OK. The program was led by Phillip L. Barkus, Dosar Barkus Band Chief.

Speakers were: Senator Anastacia A. Pittman (Ret), Lewis Johnson Principal Chief, Seminole Nation of Oklahoma, featured speaker Denys Vasquez-Welch, Willard Tillman, Wewoka Historian, and Representative Ajay Pittman. On Saturday – August 17, we traveled to the Fort Gibson Museum, located at Fort Gibson, OK. We concluded the celebration by having a Seminole descendants and guests dinner in Oklahoma City on Saturday evening – August 17, 2024. The event was very well organized and a splendid opportunity for Seminole descendants from across the country to meet, and share our heritage with Seminole descendants.
